C. M. E. A. MUSIC FESTIVAL

In-person for K-12 students.

Typically held in early May, the California Music Educator's Association Solo & Ensemble Festival is a well-dressed event where students present music to an adjudicator for a formal evaluation. Students are expected to be well prepared, introduce self and piece, and present one piece to be evaluated by an adjudicator. Standards include: tone, technique, musicianship, interpretation, etc. Details are subject to change and are made by the C.M.E.A.

COMMUNITY PERFORMANCES

In-person & virtual options for students of all ages and levels.

Join us in brightening our community with these local performances that are scheduled throughout the year. Our in-person community performances are held in cafes, art galleries, retirement communities, and the like. We also encourage our students to contribute a recording to our Virtual Community Performance which we share with assisted living homes who are not able to have in-person visitors. H. P. S. MUSIC FESTIVAL

Virtual and in-person options for students of all ages and levels.

Held in the spring, the Hamilton Piano Music Festival is a well-dressed event where students present music to an adjudicator for a formal evaluation. Students are expected to be well prepared, introduce self and piece(s), and present one or two pieces to be evaluated by our staff based on universal music standards including: tone, technique, interpretation, musical effect, stage presence, etc. earning a rating of *Superior Plus, Superior, Excellent, Good/Average, Fair, or Needs improvement.*

HONORS PIANO CLASSES

For students ages 6+, all levels

Honors Piano classes are fun & educational classes designed for students ages 6 - adult that are offered throughout the year. Rene & John choose stimulating topics that "tempt the tummy" of musicians of all levels.

JITTERS NITE

In-person event for adults
